I found a [recipe](#) for French peppered steak with a Dijon sauce that I absolutely fell in love with when I was in school. I can be a bit of a perfectionist when it comes to cooking, and so I kept making this recipe over and over. Each time, I’d change little things, but I always felt like something was missing.

Fast-forward to a few months ago, when a few Cartograph Circle members put me onto the [2016 Saltonstall Pinot](#) noir as they were talking about it at the tasting room. I took a bottle home with me that night, paired it with that recipe, and now I cannot say enough about this pinot. The lushness of the wine in combination with the earthiness, minerality, and brininess make the 2016 Saltonstall a perfect pinot to enjoy with food.
