FROM THE WINEMAKER: That's a Wrap

The Pinot and Cab Franc are fully tucked in for the winter, and the Riesling and Rosé just wrapped fermentation. We saw average yields but a really late harvest, and the wines are showing some big personalities right now.



We also just pulled the last of our older vines for the third and final stage of our estate vineyard replant. As that door closes, we open the door to new Riesling and Pinot blocks from the estate, which were the first blocks to get replanted.

The rain keeps falling and we're happy in the vineyard.
